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Rivet School is currently partnering with Braven, a nonprofit organization dedicated to empowering first generation and underrepresented students gain the skills, confidence, and network necessary to transition from college to meaningful careers and lives of impact. BravenX is a **free** 14-week fellowship program that starts in the Fall (end of August) and the Spring (end of January). You'll dedicate an estimated total of 4 hours per week on this program. You'll meet virtually with your cohort of other college students once a week for 2 hours and spend an additional 2 hours on preparation and project work. As a Braven fellow you will:

- Explore your values and career interests
- Build professional connections within your cohort
- Create a career plan
- Refine your resume, cover letter, and LinkedIn profile
- Practice interviewing with professionals
- Network and apply to jobs
- Participate in a capstone challenge with the chance to pitch your solutions to a real company
